IMPORTANT

These Tour-Pak side marker lights kit are exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.

1. Pictures of products and accessories.



2. First, open the Tour-Pak luggage of the original vehicle and take out the inner lining, then remove the fixed mounting plate of the tour-pak luggage. Disconnect the wiring harness of the original vehicle side lights and remove the vehicle side lights. Finally install a new one. As shown in the picture:






3. New side lights wiring harness is inserted through the outlet hole at the Tour-Pak luggage bottom (the direction indicated by the arrow). Reconnect with the overall wiring harness. Locate the original taillight wiring harness plug-in behind the cushion and disconnect it, use the product-supplied adapter cable, Reconnect according to the corresponding plug-in plug, and then pull the remaining 2 extension wires along with the vehicle wiring harness to the Tour-Pak luggage, and then connect with the other wire harnesses on the side lights on both sides, respectively. As shown in the picture:

4. After all the wiring harnesses are connected, start the vehicle first, check whether the side lights are normally on, turn on the turn signal switch, and check whether the left and right steering is synchronized. Reinstall all accessories afterwards. As shown in the picture:
